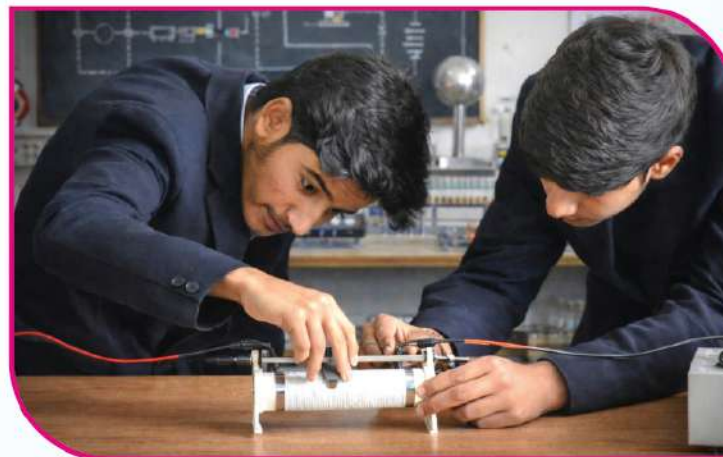

Admission & School Rules

Admission

1. Registration is compulsory but does not guarantee admission.
2. Required documents: Student photographs, parents' photographs, Birth Certificate, and Transfer Certificate/previous report card (if applicable).
3. Name and date of birth once recorded will remain final.
4. The school reserves the right to grant or refuse admission.

Fees

1. Fees are payable from 1st to 10th of every month.
2. Late payment will attract a ₹50 fine.
3. Parents must keep fee receipts safely.

Attendance & Leave

1. Regular attendance and punctuality are mandatory.
2. Leave must be applied for in writing by parents/guardians.
3. Absence without permission may attract a ₹10 per day fine.
4. Continuous absence for more than 10 days without approved leave may result in removal from the school rolls.

Parent Cooperation

1. Parents are expected to cooperate with the school in maintaining discipline and supporting academic progress.
2. Parents should not visit classrooms or meet teachers during school hours unless officially called.

Discipline

Students must maintain respectful behaviour and avoid:

1. Disobedience or disrespect toward staff
2. Damage to school property
3. Bullying, ragging, or misconduct
4. Use of foul or inappropriate language

Prohibited Items

Students are not allowed to bring mobile phones, electronic gadgets, jewellery, expensive items, junk food, or plastic bags/bottles to school.

School Transport

1. School transport facilities are provided for students as per route availability.
2. Any addition or discontinuation of bus service must be informed at least two months in advance.
3. Failing this, two months' transport fee will be payable.

Withdrawal

1. One month's written notice is required for withdrawal of a student.
2. School Leaving Certificate will be issued only after clearing all dues.
3. The school may withdraw a student for irregular attendance, unsatisfactory progress, or misconduct.

School Schedule & Uniform

1. Pre- Primary Classes Follow a 5Day Week Schedule.
2. Students (Class-1-12) are required to wear their house uniform on Wednesday and Saturday as per their lotted houses.
